Directing: Structured using a workshop format, Directing studies the principles, procedures, and practices required to direct a play. With an aggressive emphasis on collaboration, compromise, problem-solving and leadership skills, the course will explore preparation and rehearsal techniques, themes, and theatrical territories while encouraging students to deepen their own distinctive theatrical style.

Beginning Acting: Based on the Stanislavski technique, students are trained in the fundamentals of the acting process. Emphasis is placed on team building, collaboration, and playing a strong objective. This course should prepare students for further levels of study.

Advanced Acting: Building off of the fundamental building blocks established in Beginning Acting, this course encourages and expects students to deepen their understanding of the physical, vocal, and emotional demands of the acting process. This course requires considerable outside work.

Finding Life in the Page: Working directly with the author and instructor, this course is a journey through adapting Morgan Callan Rogers' debut novel "Red Ruby Heart in a Cold Blue Sea" into a provocative theatrical piece.

Acting I: Introduces students to the physical, vocal, psychological, and intellectual demands of the acting process. This course heightens students' awareness of themselves, their environment, and others.

Acting II: Performing Heightened Moments: Love, Language and Stage Combat: We will use heightened text (Shakespeare, Moliere, and others) to investigate what happens when words are insufficient and scenes escalate to passion and violence. Students will be introduced to the basics of hand-to-hand combat and will stage realistic and safe fight sequences. Using advanced scene study, the class will be given tools to rehearse and respectfully approach moments of stage intimacy.

Making Theater: Introduces students to the creative, psychological, intellectual, and logistical demands of creating a theater piece. Transitions from actively reflecting on live productions to performing traditional theater scenes to the challenging task of developing the student's own work. The course culminates with the students producing an original theater piece, gaining confidence in their unique artistic goals.

Unleashing the Power of Shakespeare's Voice: Using a variety of media, the class explores Shakespeare's profound impact on the lives of performers and the audience alike. Students attend several live performances/events in addition to learning textual analysis, emotional response, and historical context to deepen their understanding of Shakespeare's work.

Acting II Voice & Text: This rigorous course challenges students to investigate character development through vocal choices and textual roadmaps.
