### Teaching—Brief Descriptions

2020-Present Bates College Lewiston, Maine | Assistant Professor of Dance

#### **DANC 151 Making Dances I**

Student Artists learn fundamental composition skills from a variety of embodied arts genres from dance, theatre, visual arts, sound, and light design.

#### **DANC 251 Making Dances II**

Student Artists continue their compositional development by taking on a cast and begin the development of ensemble building, community care, production design integration, and culminates in a class-produced concert in our Marcy Plavin Studio venue.

#### **DANC 253 Dance Repertory**

Student Artists have an opportunity to work with three or four regional and national guest artists in two-week intensive rehearsal processes that premiere in the Marcy Plavin Dance Concert. Guests and student artists create original work and learn about different creative processes and how to maintain work throughout the semester.

#### DANC/AMST (American Studies) 262 Embodying Activism

A praxis-based course intended to empower and generate a living definition of embodying activism when engaging race, power, privilege, and colonialism. Through a series of social justice lensings, student artists determine for themselves what they consider activism and how they would engage that distinction throughout their creative process, careers, or any circle of influence.

#### DANC 270 C Studio: Modern Partnering

This intermediate-level course focuses on foundational understandings of weight, momentum, kinesiology, and structural anatomy regarding how to partner safely. This course also introduces artists to touch and consent and how to cultivate an environment of courageous co-created spaces of embodied integrity.

#### **DANC 270 D Studio: Repertory Styles**

This course runs parallel to DANC 253 and is the vehicle to refine the stylistic skills required to accomplish the works that are developed between the guest artists and students artists.

#### **DANC 270 I Studio: Improvisation**

Student Artists engage with many improvisation techniques, including solo score, vocal sounding, spatial recognition, non-contact partnering, ensemble building, contact improvisation, and the construction of scores. The course focuses on the praxis of meta-cognitive composition. Put another way, how are they simultaneously audience and performer at once?

#### DANC 270 T/THEA270 T Studio: Physical Theater

An introductory theater and dance course to familiarize and cultivate physical theater skills that translate to both disciplines. Some of the many aspects of the course will include partnering, contact improvisation, weight sharing, stage combat basics, creating spatial and physical relationships, Touch Literacy with integrated Consent Scaffolding, and vocal techniques to build a solid Physical Theater foundation.

#### **DANC 300 Bates Dance Festival**

For students with previous kinesthetic training who can demonstrate fluency and commitment to their practice, this course provides Bates students with the opportunity to participate in the Bates Dance Festival Professional Training Program. Full participation in the program requires 30 weekly hours of technical training across multiple dance disciplines and theoretical practices. Festival courses are taught by leading scholars, artists, and practitioners in their fields. An integral part of this course is attending festival concerts, informal showings, discussions, and video presentations.

#### **DANC 351 Advance Composition Seminar**

This seminar course facilitates a deeper dive into production considerations throughout the creative process. The course culminates in the main stage dance show for the semester. The student artists are creating an 8-10 min work with a cast they select from our Open Dance Day event, which attracts a large pool of folx who want to dance, both in and outside of the dance program. Student artists gain insights by comparing and contrasting one another's creative processes and cultivate critical feedback skills, while honing their artistic aesthetic. Student artists also prepare an Artist Statement, Artist Manifesto, Curricular Vitae, and dance reel they present on a website of their creation.

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#### **DANC 360 Independent Study**

The student designs and plans the independent study, in consultation with the faculty advisor. The work must be completed during the semester or short term for which the student has registered for the course, be approved by a Bates department or program, and be supervised by a Bates faculty member who is responsible for the evaluation of the work and submission of a grade.

#### DANC 457/458 Senior Thesis

A substantial dance-related project, usually in the form of choreography, performance, or a written project. Successful completion of this course qualifies as a thesis credit toward the dance major, and is the culminating project for the Student Artist.

#### AMST (American Studies) 457/458 Senior Thesis

Under the supervision of a faculty advisor, all majors write an extended essay that utilizes the methods of at least two disciplines.

#### FYS (First-Year Seminar) 556 Embodying Activism

Extensive First-Year advising in addition to being designated a level 1 writing attentive course. W1 level are focused on helping students to develop a useful process for writing, to transfer the writing skills with which they enter college to their studies at Bates, and to acquire a foundation of skills that they can then transfer to writing in subsequent courses. A praxis-based course intended to empower and generate a living definition of embodying activism when engaging race, power, privilege, and colonialism. Through a series of social justice lensings, student artists determine for themselves what they consider activism and how they would engage that distinction throughout their creative process, careers, or any circle of influence.
